

The Financial Planners Standards Council (FPSC) recognized Lovett-Reid with the 2009 Donald J. Johnston Award for her outstanding contribution to the profession of financial planning in Canada. In 2011, Lovett-Reid was awarded the Financial Planning Canada Fellow of Distinction and in 2007 and received Canada's Most Powerful Women: Top 100[™] Award in the Trailblazers and Trendsetters Category.
